

Erasmus+



Study abroad

- Study at a partner institution of the faculty of physics
- duration: 3 12 months
- Erasmus grant of at least 300 € a month (2018/19)



Work abroad

- Traineeship in countries of the European Union, Island, Lichtenstein, Macedonia, Norway and Turkey
- duration: at least 8 weeks, up to 12 months
- Erasmus grant of at least 400 € a month (2018/19)





Study abroad as "free mover"/visiting student

Most universities allow students to study up to one year as visiting non-degree student!

- tuition fees have to be paid
- funding of such a stay is up to the student, e.g. grants (PROMOS, DUE-Mobil, other programs of the DAAD,...)
- ⇒ You need to be proactive!

Research Internships in Science and Engineering

Research internship around the world during summer

Bachelor students

Monthly grant, travel costs, health insurance

German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)
Application: November/December

"Auslands-BAföG"

- study and internships abroad
- worldwide
- financial support for up to one year
- BAföG basic amount plus surcharge (non EU countries),
 travel costs and tuition fees (up to 4600 € per year)
- for students of physics: the period of time during which you receive Auslands-BAföG does not count to the maximal period of time of BAföG benefits



Grants

- Study abroad worldwide for 6 or 12 months
- funding depends on grand and target country
- most important funding organisation:
 German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)



PROMOS/DUE-Mobil

- Study and internships abroad (in countries that do non participate in Erasmus+)
- Summer schools and other specialised course worldwide
- duration max 6 months



How to apply for a scholarship

Choose a country and a university

Look for funding opportunities

Apply at the guest university and for funding

Required documents depend on scholarship donor Selection process

Prepare your stay abroad: insurances, housing, apply for holiday semester,...



Will a stay abroad delay my studies?

There is a chance that a stay abroad prolongs your studies, but:

- there is a good reason for an additional semester
- you gain so much experience that the time delay is relative
- a stay abroad testifies flexibility, motivation and more
- international competence is an essential skill in a global world
- you can take a holiday semester

Conclusion: A stay abroad is well worth a delay of your studies!
