Following her Master's (Universität Leipzig) and PhD (Universität Konstanz) in solid state physics looking at two-dimensional materials, Julia Tesch went on to study science communication at the University of Manchester. Doing so opened up an entirely new world of science-related careers beyond the conventional choice of academia vs. industry. At Physikalisch-Technische Bundesanstalt (PTB), a departmental research institution of the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action, she now leads the Presidential Staff Office for Communication and hopes to spark passion for precision measurements in a much broader audience, with a particular focus on the political domain.
